The Perfect Diary 2005 also features a retrospective of the last decade of celebrating Australia's best and finest, adding up to 121 visual and literary treats to help make 2005 an inspiring year.

This unique and amazing publication, conceived and produced entirely in Australia, is also jammed with entertaining quotes, information on great moments in history [the doughnut was invented on June 20 1847, Cherry Ripe was made for the first time on June 10 1880 and the Hill Hoist began production on November 22 1946] and festival and event dates around the country and the world. You can even spend the quieter moments of 2005 learning the Braille alphabet - which is embossed on the back cover!
